

Study Advisory Committee

Purpose

The Study Advisory Committee (SAC)—comprised of community members with a depth of knowledge and interests in diverse areas—shall serve as a forum to explore how the Study's approach, strategies and analysis address transportation needs and reflect community trends and values, and advise the staff at key milestones.

Charge

The SAC shall review and advise the staff on the following study milestones:

- Community values to guide the Study
- Description of transportation problems and opportunities facing the county
- Evaluation measures for use in the Study that reflect community values
- Land use scenarios that reflect plausible futures
- Conceptual level transportation strategies with illustrative projects
- Evaluation results, outcomes and trade-offs for the transportation strategies
- Conclusions and implications for next steps

Commitments

SAC members are committed to:

- Focus their deliberations on addressing their charge and supporting the purpose of the Study
- Consider a diverse range of viewpoints and work as a team
- Attend up to 10 meetings of at least 2 hours each between early 2015 and mid 2016
- Support efforts to solicit public input on the study
